Testing of DimiCare Materials Completed

The DimiCare project has reached another significant milestone. The piloting phase has been successfully completed. Over 80 care workers (in training) and more than 20 healthcare educators participated in testing the DimiCare training course and the DimiCare microlearning units for relevance, usability, and design. Their feedback has been collected and is currently being analysed to identify areas for improvement. The materials will be refined and the final version will be available on the DimiCare website by the end of October 2024.
